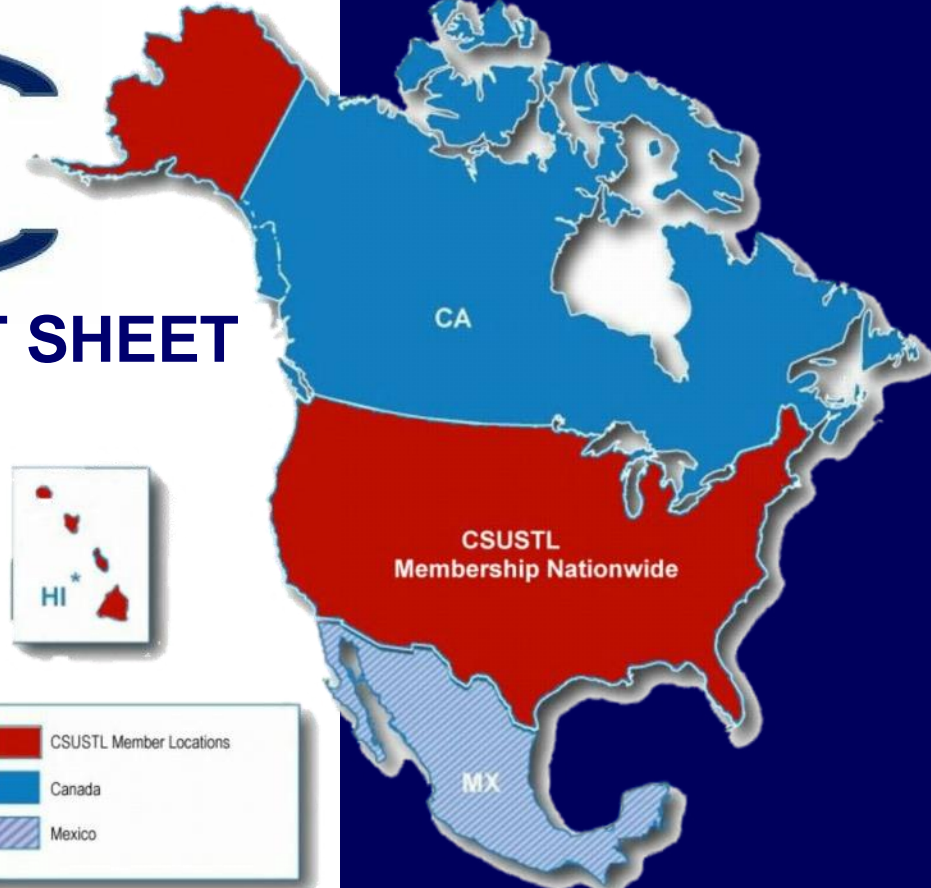




MEMBERSHIP FACT SHEET
